Dear CBAA Members,

I hope everyone is enjoying this wonderful fall weather.

I am pleased to report that our first ever summer basketball season was a resounding success. Through your support and effort, we were able to build a great basketball facility at our Herbst Field Sports Complex and, in our second season, we were able to provide a great recreational alternative on a summer's night for over 500 kids on more than 50 teams. I would like to take a moment to thank our friends and neighbors from the Doylestown Athletic Association for helping to make this happen. In particular, I would like to thank Art Bass and Loretta Jenkins for getting the word out about our summer basketball program. Their efforts made it possible for our community to enjoy a great summer basketball league.

CBAA had enthusiastic attendance at our first-ever open soccer nights at the Herbst Field Sports Complex. Each Tuesday and Thursday night in July and August, we invited our members to come out and play supervised pick-up soccer games. While these sessions were supervised by volunteer coaches from our recreational and travel soccer programs, no coaching was permitted and the kids got to choose the format of play. As said best by one of our participants: "The best thing about open soccer night is that KIDS RULE!" With your help, we look forward to making summer soccer nights an annual tradition.

This fall, the CBAA recreational soccer program also started a new tradition, with a kick-off day celebration at our Herbst Field Sports Complex. All intramural soccer players had their opening games at Herbst Field, where we offered concessions, gave our coaches their last minute team equipment, and generally created a wonderful CBAA community experience. With nearly 1,500 kids in the fall 2007 intramural soccer program, parking was a bit of a challenge, but it was great to see so many children enjoying the game of soccer. CBAA Basketball Registration Ends October 31

CBAA basketball registration is available on line, on our web site (www.cbaabasketball.net) through Wednesday, October 31, 2007. Late registration will be available beginning November 1st. A late charge of \$30 will be added and players will be assigned only if openings exist in the league. If the capacity of the league has been met, players will then be placed on a waiting list. To date, CBAA has never turned away any child, but due to limited gym time and space we do have a limit on the number of teams and players that each league can take on.

All Intramural players should plan to attend evaluations for their grade. Attendance at evaluations helps CBAA achieve our goal of parity among the teams.

Our season will begin in December with Intramural practices. Games will start after the new year. Parents and players should expect to receive a call from their coach soon after the Thanksgiving Holiday.

CBAA Basketball is still looking for sponsors and volunteers. Team sponsors help CBAA maintain the cost of registration and to pay for gym time, security, and uniforms.
