### 2020 FISHING TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. This tournament is considered the "jungle rules" format. There are no restrictions on areas to fish (except my DLNR laws), line class, length of leader, etc. Fish can be caught by using any technique, as long as it is caught from a motorized boat, human-powered boat or shore casting. Trolling dead or alive bait is allowed, teasers and birds are allowed as well.
- 2. All fish must be reported to the Tournament Director at 808-367-9984 at the beach desk as soon as it is caught and measured. This requirement is mandatory. Forwarded catch reports are allowed. The beach desk will keep track of who is winning from the club. A leaderboard will be by the beach desk. ALL CATCHES TEXTED BY 4PM to 808-367-9984. NO EXCEPTIONS TO THIS RULE. Boats can have as many anglers as they want, but 1 prize per team.
- 3. Each qualified landed fish must be measured or weighed, photographed CLEARLY and texted to the Tournament Director at 808-367-9984 by 3:30pm. You must take the photographs from directly and centered on the fish and angler. All photographs must be clear and visible. The fish must be visible from tip to tail. **Dishonesty WILL NOT be tolerated.**
- 4. **No Mutilation Rule** in effect. (\*Fish can have small defects. Examples: gaffing marks, line cuts, small cookie cutter sharks bites. However, no half fish or mutilated fish will be legal.)
- 5. Start/Stop/Check-in: Fishing starts at sunrise. No start line. Any Oahu start point is OK. CHECK IN with the Tournament Director is MANDATORY. MUST TEXT "OUT" and "IN" to Jennifer at 808-367-9984 to ensure safety of each participant. IF YOU FAIL TO CHECK "OUT" and "IN" YOU ARE SUBJECT TO DISQUALIFICATION.
